## Team Information

### What's the travel/flight information?

- When searching for flights to Romania you will need to fly into the city of **Cluj, Timisoara** or **Sibiu**.
- Remember that it is always cheaper to fly from a major international airport such as Atlanta. Also, check different routes because different airports charge different taxes. Check all routes because sometimes you can find a good deal.
- Make sure you pay attention to departure and arrival times. For example, if your return flight to the United States departs Romania at 6:00 am, that means that we will leave the hotel at 2:30 am or 3:00 am. Sometime this can not be helped, but just be aware of the time.
- Passports take a minimum of six weeks to receive after application. Make sure all your team members have an up to date passport.

### How much will it cost me?

- Your cost will all depend on your airline ticket cost.
- Your cost will be the airline ticket plus \$600 per person (typically) for your expenses in Romania.
- Your \$600 in Romania cost will cover all food, lodging, transportation, and sight-seeing cost for the entire length of stay in Romania.

### Where will I be staying while in Romania?

- We typically host our teams in a local bed and breakfast. If we receive conformation from your team in time we can book your rooms in advance. If the hotel is already booked, we have other options. **WIFI is available!**

- All rooms will have two or three persons per room. If your team members want to have a private room this will need to be reported to Jacob and Cami as soon as possible. This will of course affect the cost of those individuals.
- If you are looking for one of those difficult “roughing it” type mission trips this one is not for you. The rooms are nice and the food is great!

### **What will we be doing?**

- There is always a lot going on with our mission work in Romania. We are usually able to host all types of mission teams. From men’s construction teams, women’s evangelical teams, to youth group children’s ministry teams. Also, a mixed men and women’s team is always welcome. There is always something for everyone to get involved in sharing Christ to the people of Romania.
- Usually the exact details of what the team will be doing comes as the trip date approaches.

### **Other Helpful Information**

- Are there any special customs to know about? *No, just be yourself and show Christ’s love.*
- Will I exchange my money there? *Yes, I will take the whole team to exchange money in our local town. Do not exchange in the airport. They have the worst rates! Credit cards work great but notify your credit company in advance of your travels.*
- Can I eat all the food and drink the water? *We recommend eating and trying new things. The food is great and safe to eat. You may want to avoid food cooked on the street and in the markets. I would also suggest drinking only bottled water. It is readily available.*
- What about electrical needs? Chargers? Adaptors? Etc.? *You can buy adaptors here cheap. Just make sure your appliance/device will work with 220v and 110v.*
